We are working with Robert Campbell of Robert G. Campbell & Associates (RGC&A) to resolve the issues noted in my attached memo of June 2 to Ken Pruitt of your office

Mr. Campbell is in the process of revising their survey exhibits to adjust the right-of-way that will remain along Blackstock Avenue. He is also working with TDOT regarding construction of the turn-around area. He has been told that TDOT will not object to construction of the turn-around.

However, because neither of these issues has been fully resolved, the Engineering Department requests that this closure be approved only if subject to the following conditions:

1. The remaining right-of-way along Blackstock Avenue shall be resolved satisfactorily to the Engineering Department

2. The applicant shall design and construct a turn-around satisfactory to the Engineering Department at or near the east end of ground-level Western Avenue under the viaduct

3 The ordinance closing this right-of-way shall contain language stipulating that both these items shall be accomplished within one year of the date City Council approves it. Otherwise, this closure shall be deemed to be null and void and of no effect.
