WIRELESS TOWERS

332 (c)(7)(B)(iv)

“...(iv) No State or local government or instrumentality thereof may regulate the placement, construction, or modification of personal wireless service facilities on the basis of the environmental effects of radio frequency emissions to the extent that such facilities comply with the Commission’s regulations concerning such emissions.”

Meaning: all decisions based on radiation effects from cell and communication towers/antennas are solely the responsibility of the FCC and not local zoning or planning offices. Local and state agencies do not have authority to make any decisions on tower siting based on radiation effects of the transmitting facility.
